- Retreat is Nov. 8; exec and strategic planning committees are working together - Remove the 11/15 meeting from your calendars because we'll get that business at the retreat - Jody announced that after a lot of reflection during her month sabbatical, she decided she'd like 2024 to be her last year. It was always the plan to not stay more than 10, and this feels like the right time Lots of time to manage this transition in an intentional way to make sure the organization is strong and supported - Deborah: You've been an outstanding leader, and have shown us what professional leadership looks like in an organization. We'll find someone who will also take us to that level. It's a time of transformation Deborah: Jody's staff nominated her for the Chamber of Commerce 2023 boss of the year award! She is 1 of 12 being interviewed by students about leadership development. The Chamber will narrow to 3 finalists based on students' feedback.
